*...Last night we were in the village distributing relief here in American Samoa. At the first "makeshift house" that we came to, we visited a couple whose 6 year old daughter was killed in the tsunami last week. They had just completed a funeral service for her earlier in the day. We provided them with the relief items and then sat with them, prayed with them, shed tears with them, and talked. The mother was bruised and cut from the turbulent tsunami....but I suppose that her physical injuries pale by comparison to the emotional injury that she and her husband now have upon their hearts. Place after place we came upon similar circumstances. Although some had not lost family members, they nonetheless were caught up and swept away in the tsunami.....a frightening ordeal to recall. It breaks our hearts, but we know that God can comfort beyond what we as humans can imagine. We must serve these people in their greatest hour of need, both physically and spiritually, that they may glorify God in heaven.*

*Please pray for the people of the Samoan Islands, and for the members of the body of Christ as together we serve. In just a few days, we'll again return to the nearby nation of Samoa in order that we may assist members of the church in their recovery efforts.*
