Date: 2/10/2010

Today, Team 4 is on its way to Port au Prince. Roberta reports that she has already distributed about 50,000 lbs of food, and has several more tons at her house waiting to be packaged for the families. The security walls have been closed to a height of about six feet, and gates have been installed at the group house. The church is receiving compliments on its show of Christian generosity, & worship is standing room only. For the next few weeks we will focus on keeping some helpers on hand to facilitate food distribution.
